This Indenture made and executed this 19th day of July A.D. One thousand eight hundred and
forty one, Between between Harrison Nursey and Nancy his wife of the first part Anthony
B. Vaughan husband of the second part and Matthew W. Vaughan of the third part all of the County of Southampton
and state of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Harrison Nursey and Nancy his wife stands justly
indebted to the said Anthony Vaughan in the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars
which appears by note bearing date with these presents and the said Harrison Nursey and Nancy
his wife being desirous to secure the payment of the aforesaid debt and all costs pertaining thereto
and more especially for the sum of One dollar to them in hand paid by the said Matthew
W. Vaughan the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and do by these
presents bargain and sell alientate and confess unto the said Matthew W. Vaughan his execs
adms and assigns forever. The following property vizt One tract of land containing sixty two
and eighty acres it being the tract of land the said Harrison Nursey purchased of the said
Anthony Vaughan One sorrel mare One Cart and wheely two feather beds and furniture One
shot gun twelve head of hogs two sitting chairs One Apple tree Two pots One Spider One
Pew and an ironing board upon the following ^{as follows} condition and trust to wit if the
said Harrison Nursey shall fail to pay the aforesaid debt with all costs pertaining thereto when
ever required by the said Anthony Vaughan it shall then lawful and right for the said
Matthew W. Vaughan as soon as required by the said Anthony Vaughan his execs adms or
assigns after giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale at least three public
places in the neighbourhood to sell the aforesaid property for cash and out of the proceeds of
such sale first pay all costs pertaining to this and then pay unto the said Anthony Vaughan
his execs adms and assigns the amount of the aforesaid debt and the overplus if any pay
over to the aforesaid Harrison Nursey and Nancy his wife or order and to convey unto the
purchaser or purchasers a good and sufficient title and right to the aforesaid property and every
part whereof thereof. The said Matthew W. Vaughan do hereby obligate and agrees to fulfil on
