We Jacob Barnes and James Mize, Justices of the Peace in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia do hereby certify that Rebecca Vick the wife of Jacob Vick and Elizabeth Porter the wife of Jacob Porter parties to a certain deed bearing date on the 12th day of June 1841 and hereto annexed personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from their husbands and having the deed aforesaid fully explained to them they the said Rebecca Vick and Elizabeth Porter acknowledged the same to be their act and deed and declared that they had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same and that wished not to retract it. This Indenture made and entered into on the 12th day of June in the year of our Lord eight hundred and forty One Between Lydia Vick (widow of James Vick dec'd) Jacob Vick and Rebecca his wife Jacob Porter and Elizabeth his wife William Vick John Vick and Maria Vick his wife all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the One part and James Vick of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Lydia Vick Jacob Vick and Rebecca his wife Jacob Porter and Elizabeth his wife William Vick John Vick and Maria his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said James Vick at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the said James Vick his heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's containing by the Survey Twenty five and One fourth Acres (exclusive of two acres attached to the rail Road) be the same more or less it being lot No. 20 shown by said James Vick in the division of the two tracts of land of James Vick dec'd (exclusive of the widows dower land) as divided by Jacob Barnes Esq. Silas Ellwood and Benjamin Burns Commissioners appointed by the heirs of said James Vick to lay off the widows dower in the said two tracts of land and to divide the balance into five parts or lots equal in value. And bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a lighted post or corner for Lydia Vick dower land in Benjamin E. Burns line thence along said Burns
