

Line 18. 61 1/4 poles to a red oak thence 90. 6 1/2 poles to a pine stump near the rail road (on the South side) thence 13. 6 22 poles to a pine in John R. Turner line thence his line 27. 6 25 poles to a small black Jack a corner thence 65. 7 1/2 poles to a large tree standing in a branch a corner for said John R. Turner in Joel Vicks line thence up the run of said branch to fifty feet North of the center of the rail road a corner for Lot 17 drawn by John Vicks in said Joel Vicks line thence along said John Vicks line parallel with the rail road N 75 1/2. 6 13 poles to a ditch thence along the center of said ditch N 21. 6 30 1/2 poles to a post a corner for said John Vicks in the said lower line thence along the lower line S 85 1/2. 6 10 feet to a post a corner for said lower land thence N 20. 6 14 poles to a post and pine stump thence N 47 1/2. 6 15 poles to the beginning. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appurtenant (except the part attached to rail road as aforesaid) unto him the said James Vicks his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Vicks his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lydia Vicks Sarah Vicks and Rebecca his wife Jacob Peter and Elizabeth his wife William Vicks John Vicks and Maria his wife for themselves their heirs executors and assigns do and each of them with hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said James Vicks his heirs executors assigns and assigns that they do by these presents relinquish their respective claims to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land Lot 17 unto him the said James Vicks his heirs and assigns forever and that they will by these presents covenant and forever defend all the right and title thereto (except as above excepted) against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
