This Indenture made and entered into on the fifteenth day of April One Thousand eight hundred and forty one in and between William B Edwards of the first part and Thomas Harwood of the second part and Samuel R Gardner of the third part and all the parties of the County of Southampton one State of Virginia Witnesseth that whereas the said William B Edwards stands justly indebted unto the said Thos Harwood in the just and full sum of One hundred and fifty one dollars lawful money of Virginia which appears by his books bearing date with these presents and made payable from the date thereof known the said William B Edwards being willing and desirous to indemnify and secure the payment of the above debt but more especially for the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by him the said Samuel R Gardner before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged (Wit) That he the said William B Edwards hath granted bargained and sold and sold by these presents grant bargain and sell to him the said Samuel R Gardner his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit 61 acres of land 12 hogs 2 feather beds and furniture one Cart and wheels and gear 1 Chest all his household and Kitchen furniture his farming tools his Crop of all kinds now made by one mow and every other one made and any interest in the land and Oranges belonging to Mrs Elizabeth Johnson until the above debt is paid to him the said Samuel R Gardner his heirs and assigns forever Upon the following trust (Wit) That if the said William B Edwards shall fail to pay and discharge the above debt and all cost pertaining to this Trust it shall be lawful and right in that event for him the said Samuel R Gardner as soon as required in writing from him the said Thomas Harwood his heirs or assigns to set up and sell for Cash the above land and property or so much as will pay the above debt and all cost pertaining to this Trust after giving public notice by advertisement to be set up at different places in the neighbourhood of the said land and property the said land and property is to remain in the possession of him the said William B Edwards until call for by him the said Samuel R Gardner Trustee.
