Whereas the parties of the third part have become securities for the said General P. Nicholson in a bill executed on the 13th day of April 1841 in the sum of four thousand dollars and made payable to Alfred P. Bailey administrator of James Scott for the sum of four thousand dollars and the said Nicholson being willing and desirous to secure and indemnify them against all loss and damage whatever on account of their said securityship hath agreed to Convey the property herein after mentioned unto the said Littleton R. Edwards in trust to be sold for that purpose. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said General P. Nicholson and Mary & his wife in consideration of the promises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to them in hand paid by the said Littleton R.
