 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William Nicholson hath granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth grant bargained and sold unto the said John M. Mason all that parcel of
 Land situate in the County of Southampton Containing One hundred and twenty two acres it being the
 share which in the division of the lands of Thos. Nicholson dec^d was allotted to the said Wm. Nicholson
 The Mates and bounds of which parcel of land will more fully appear by reference to the report of A. P. Fox, Henry C. Vaughan and David Morris Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton
 To make division of said decedents land and by a plat and survey made by John M. Mathews accom-
 paingning said Commissioners report now of Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court
 To have and to hold the said parcel of Land with all and singular its appurtenances to him the said
 John M. Mason and to his heirs and the said William Nicholson, ^{for himself and his heirs} communis with the said John M. Mason and his heirs that he shall have and enjoy a good title to the said tract of Land and
 quiet possession of the same. And I doth witness whereof the said William Nicholson hath hereunto

 Between Brown Douglass and Nancy his wife of the first part and Simon Marjor of the second part above them
 of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Brown Douglass and Nancy his
 wife have for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and seventy five dollars to them in hand by the
 said Simon Marjor the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold and so by these presents
 bargained and sold unto the said Simon Marjor his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract and parcel of Land Containing One hundred and eighteen acres more or less and bounded as follows
 Diz beginning at a black gum a corner of this tract and across Cobb's Run in Davis' bottom then
 N 73° E 83° ft to a large white gum thence N 66° E 61° ft to an old stump thence N 72° E 82° ft to a pine thence
 East 7° ft to another pine corner between Davis' bottom and Doctor Ely thence N 82° E 11° ft to a cut gum thence
 N 74° E 60° ft to a cut gum corner of this tract and Doctor Ely in the Doctor's tract thence N 53° W 26° ft along the road
 to a small pine common to N 31° W 30° ft to a Row oak thence N 30° W 30° ft to a post at a pine stump thence N 72° W 17° ft
 to another post at another pine stump thence East 3° p. 12 links to a small pine thence N 57° E 32° ft to a pine thence N 40° E
 61° ft to a white oak thence S 30° W 20° ft to a Row oak a side line thence N 73° W 6° ft to another oak stump thence
 N 24° E 16° ft to a pine thence N 55° E 6° ft to a pine thence N 77° E 8° ft to a small black gum thence N 73° S 30° ft
