I know all men by these presents that I Nancy Briggs and for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred dollars in hand paid by Joel Harris hath given granted bargained and sold and do by these presents give grant bargain and sell unto the said Joel Harris my plantation in the County of Southampton containing two hundred and ninety nine acres more or less together with all the privileges and advantages thereto in any manner appertaining the said plantation or tract of land bounded as follows to wit on the North by the tract of Land now owned by Mrs. Levi Waller formerly owned by Mrs. Polly Newson on the East by the tract of Land belonging to Mrs. John McGlowny on the West by the tract of Land belonging to Mrs. Richard Clements and on the South by the tract of Land belonging to Mrs. Lucy Parker and the Cornet swamp and I hereby Covenant that I will lawfully defend in fee of the above named tract of Land that it is free from all incumbrances and that I have a perfect right to convey the same in fee simple and I Covenant that I will and that my heirs shall warrant and defend the said tract of Land to the said Joel Harris and his heirs against the Claims of all persons.
