This Indenture made the day of in the year 1841 between John Harris and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Jacob Meade of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Harris and Mary his wife in consideration of a sum of money of this commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Jacob Meade at or before the making and delivery of these presents have bargained and sold unto the said Jacob Meade his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and bounded as follows beginning at a pine corner between John Harris and Jacob Meade thence to a person corner between John Harris and James McLennan thence to a pine corner between Jacob Meade and James McLennan thence to the beginning containing Four Acres be the same more or less together with every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said land with the parts and premises before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto every part and parcel thereof with every of their right members and appurtenances unto the said Jacob Meade his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Harris and Mary his wife for themselves and their heirs the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Jacob Meade his heirs and assigns free from the claims or claims of them the said John Harris and Mary his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons what soever shall will and do warrant and defend by them persons. Whereas the said William Johnson is justly indebted to the said Mills & Lawrence in the sum of One hundred dollars by bond bearing date with these presents which debt with legal interest thereon the said William Johnson is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of One dollar to the said William Johnson in hand paid by the said Jacob H Duck at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William Johnson both given granted bargained and sold unto by these presents as give grant bargain and sell unto the said Jacob H Duck his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit: One bay mare and colt three head of cattle three head of hogs two fowling birds and furniture and one cart and wherry. To have and to hold the said property above mentioned unto him the said Jacob H Duck his heirs and assigns forever. Upon trust nevertheless that the said Jacob H Duck as soon as he conveniently can after the first day of January 1842 and having ascertained the time and place of sale of said property by three annual advertisements to be posted up at the most public place in the said County.
