Barnes of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Christian Jordan for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety five dollars and six and a half Cents Current Money of this Commonwealth to her in hand paid by the said Robert P. Barnes at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Robert P. Barnes his heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract or parcel of Land (situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke) Containing by a late survey Twenty two and a half acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at the intersection of the Arthur swamp and the road leading from the backshop to Monroe a corner for Thomas B.
