Witnesseth that the said Christian Jordan for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety five dollars and Sixty two and a half Cents Current Money of this Commonwealth to her in hand paid by the said Robert J. Barney at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold alienated enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Robert J. Barney his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land (situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke Containing by a late survey Sixty two and a half acres to the same more or less and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at the intersection of the Arthur swamp and the road leading from the brookings to Monroe a corner for Thomas B.
