 Southampton. Office - and whereas the object of the said deed of Trust has been finally
 adjusted and settled as will appear the said Barham being party to this deed and the parties
 are anxious to release the property and interest conveyed by the said deed of Trust so as to

 Now the said Littleton R. Edwards and Nicholas J. Barham hereby do release acquit convey

 one of the partners and disclaimants of Peter Booth deceased who was a brother of Peter Booth
 late of Southampton County and as said the said Henry Booth is indebted to an interest
 of the estate of the said Peter Booth now in the hands of Executors Butts the said debt is now
 of the said Peter Booth and which is the subject of a controversy now in the hands of the
 Court of Law and Chy for Southampton County in the suit depending in which Nicholas J.
