a Certain deed of Trust to One Littleton R Edwards aforesaid for the purpose of securing and
benefiting the said Bartham as will appear by the said deed received in the County Court of
Southampton. Office - and whereas the object of the said deed of Trust has been finally
adjusted and settled as will appear the said Bartham being party to this deed and the parties
and uncles, to release the property and interest conveyed by the said deed of Trust so as to
rest the same absolutely in the said Henry Booth as if the said deed had not been made
Now the said Littleton R Edwards and Nicholas of Bartham hereby do release acquit convey
to the said Henry Booth all the right title interest and property of any kind whatsoever conveyed by
the said Henry Booth to said Littleton R Edwards to be the property of said Booth and his
Executors and assigns as fully as if the said conveyance had never been made by the said
