fodder hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted unto them the said Littlepage Anderson Trustee his
heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behooff of ... The said Littlepage
Anderson his heirs Executors administrators assigns forever and the said James Burgeff for himself his heirs Executors
and administrators hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Littlepage Anderson Trustee
his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend all
right and title to the aforesaid two thirds of his present Crop of Corn and fodder against the
Claims or demands of all and every persons or persons whatsoever upon special trust and confidence of
mortality to and for the use intent and purposes following that is to say that he the said Littlepage
Anderson Trustee his legal representatives or assigns may and shall at any time here after when he
shall be thereto requested by either of the parties make sale of the aforesaid Corn and fodder
at public auction to the highest bidder for ready money or so much thereof as will be sufficient
for the purpose after giving at least ten days previous notice of the time and place of sale by
posting up there or more advertisements at public places in the neighbourhood and out of
the proceeds of such sale after paying all Costs and expences attending the execution of these
presentes pay unto him the said Henry Jones his heirs or assigns the aforesaid sum of One
hundred and thirty two shillings and eight pence and the legal interest thereon according and the over
plus if any pay unto him the said James Burgeff his heirs or assigns. For Moneys whereof

This Indenture made and entered into this twentieth day of September one thousand eight
hundred and forty one between William Fymer and Mary his wife of the first part and Polly
Fymer of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of the M^{ch} Metrop^{olis} that whereas
the said William Fymer and Mary his wife doth for and in Consideration of the sum of six shillings
to them in hand paid by the said Polly Fymer at or before the making and delivery of these pre-
sents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged grant bargain and sell unto the said Polly
Fymer her heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract or parcel of Land containing by
estimation thirty acres, be the same more or less being in the County of Southampton
and Newbury Parish and bounded as follows beginning at a post planted at the edge of the
road in William Fymer line thence along a straight line to possession tree in said Fymer
line and continuing a straight line to a post planted for a corner in said William Fymer line
and Polly Fymer line thence to a black Oak in said Fymer line thence to a post Oak
