Stephenson. This Indenture made and entered into this 5th April 1841 between Polly Stephenson of the County of Salisbury and State of Virginia of the one part and William L Stephenson of the County of Southampton and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Polly Stephenson for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said William L Stephenson at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Polly Stephenson doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said William L Stephenson his heirs and assigns by these presents hath granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William L Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton containing by estimation thirty eight acres more or less being the tract of Land formerly owned and enjoyed possessed by Samuel Stephenson and willed to and the said Polly Stephenson which said is now proved in the Clerk's Office in the County of Southampton on the 16th day of March 1841 and bounded as follows to wit Commencing at James & Henry River N. M. Williams & Stephenson N. D. Miller Esqy & John Johnsons heirs S. M. and thence to the first station with the appurtenances to the said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversioners remainders and remainder rents issues and profits unto the said William L Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Polly Stephenson hereby covenants to and with the said William L Stephenson to warrant and forever defend
