William B. Stephenson made and entered into this first day of July 1821 between James Williams of the
 County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the first part James Cobb of the same County & state
 of the second part and Abram Reddick of the County of Stafford and state of North Carolina of the
 third part whereas the said Williams is indebted to the said Reddick by bond bearing date
 with this Instrument to the amount of four hundred sixty five dollars Eighty two Cents which
 debt the said Williams is willing and desirous to pay the payment of the said sum of money
 to the said Reddick and is willing and desirous to save him trouble and free from suing
 Now this Instrument witnessed that for and in Consideration of the premises and the sum
 of one dollar to him in hand paid by James Cobb trustee for the said Williams both given
 granted bargained and sold unto him the said Cobb the following property to wit Viz One
 hundred and fifty acres of Land more or less bounded by the lands of Joseph Feltow
 James Council and others of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia One horse
 saddle and bridle One bedstead and furniture Twenty hogs Twenty Eels Corn One
 thousand pounds of Bacon also my entire stock of goods with the privilege of selling
 and buying so that I keep the stock as good as it now is to him and his heirs forever
 upon trust notwithstanding that the said Williams is to retain possession of all the above conveyed
 property until required by the said Reddick to be sold. Whereupon the said James Cobb
 trustee shall after advertising the time and place of sale proceed to sell so much of said
 property as is required to satisfy the above named debt with Interest Costs &c. For
