And Indenture made this 24th day of September 1841 between John A Turner of the first part James D Boyant of the second part and John M Burley John A Wells and Henry Kindred of the third part. Whereas the said John A Turner is justly indebted to the said John M Burley in the sum of One hundred dollars due upon judgment on which a fi. fac. has issued with interest on the said sum from the 17th day of April 1841 and also the sum of \$4. 34 for Costs incurred in said suit and whereas the said John A Turner is justly indebted to John A Wells in the sum of \$48. with interest from the 16th day of June 1840 and \$7. 34 for Costs incurred in said suit which sum is due on judgment on which a Ca. Sa. has issued and whereas the said John A Turner is justly indebted to Henry Kindred in the sum of \$62. 44 for interest thereon from the 15th day of October 1840 and 7. 34 for Costs which sum is due by judgment on which a Ca. Sa. has issued the payment whereof the said John A Turner is desirous to secure and release his body from Custody of the Law This Indenture witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the premises and for the full Consideration of One dollar in hand paid by the said James D Boyant the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John A Turner does by these presents grant bargain sell and Convey unto the said James D Boyant his heirs and assigns his present growing Crop of Cotton and any and all surplus whatever that may be coming to him the said John A Turner after satisfying the trust deeds which he has made and entered into previously to this date. Upon trust nevertheless that the said James D Boyant shall when required by the said John M Burley John A Wells and Henry Kindred their Executors administrators or assigns do to do sell the said growing Crop of Cotton and the said surplus after satisfying and discharging the trust deeds herebefore made by him or such part thereof as shall be sufficient for the purpose at public auction to the highest bidder for ready money after having given the time and place of sale at his own discretion and given one month's notice thereof at two or more public places in the County of Southampton and out of the proceeds of sale shall after satisfying the expenses thereof and all other expenses attending the execution of the trust pay to the said John M Burley John A Wells and Henry Kindred their Executors administrators or assigns the debts aforesaid Cost and interest thereon or such part thereof as may be due and the balance if any pay to the said John A Turner his heirs Executors administrators or assigns but if the whole of the said debts and accruing interest shall be fully paid off and discharged to the said John M Burley John A Wells and Henry Kindred their Executors administrators or assigns then this Indenture shall be void or else remain in full force.
