Whereas by a decree entered in the County Court of Southampton at Ordinary Term last the said Jesse Drury was appointed Trustee to carry into effect the provisions of a deed of trust executed by William Tucker to Joseph Tucker dec'd. to secure a debt due James Tucker dec'd. and when in pursuance of said decree the said Jesse Drury did on the 7th day of October last (express) to sell and the premises the tract of Land and appurtenances conveyed in said deed (containing by estimation nearly six Acres) which Harrison D.
