This Indenture made and entered into this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September 1841 between James Blythe and  
Amy his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas C Jones of the other part witnesseth  
that the said James Blythe and Amy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand five  
of Lawful Money to them in hand paid by the said Thomas C Jones (the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged) have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell  
confirm unto the said Thomas C Jones his heirs and assigns certain tract or parcel of Land lying  
and being in the County aforesaid. Containing by Estimation nearly Acre, be the same more or less  
bounded as follows beginning at a white oak on the side of the road in the edge of the Horse  
past branch thence around said Branch to the Corner of Drury and Fiddell in Flag run then  
up said run to the Cypress bridge road thence around said road to the beginning. To have  
and to hold the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances therunto in any  
wise then the said Thomas C Jones his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and  
behalf of him the said Thomas C Jones his heirs and assigns. And the said James Blythe and  
Amy his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns do hereby Covenant promise and agree  
to and with the said Thomas C Jones his heirs and assigns that they will warrant and defend  
the right and title to the said tract or parcel of Land unto promising unto the said Thomas C  
Jones his heirs and assigns forever against the Claims of them the said Blythe and wife  
and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. In Testimony whereof the said James
