This deed of bargain and sale from James Rly the and wife to Thomas R Conry was returned and
together with the Certifying annexed admitted to Record—

Lawrence of the first part and Henry Doyal of the second part the first of the County of Isle of Wight and
State of Virginia and the second of the State of Mississippi. Witnesseth that the said John B Lawrence
for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Henry
Doyal at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
the said John B Lawrence hath sold bargain and granted and by these presents doth sell bargain
and convey unto the said Henry Doyal his heirs or assigns one certain tract of Land lying and
being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by estimation two hundred and
fifty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows Viz on the south by Tucker's swamp
on the east by John Boykin on the North by the North Turnpike and on the west by John Brown and others
which said tract of Land the said John B Lawrence purchased of Edward Butts under a deed
together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and to hold the said
tract of Land with all its appurtenances unto the said Henry Doyal his heirs or assigns
for ever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry Doyal his heirs or assigns
for ever and the said John B Lawrence covenants promises and agrees to warrant and defend
such right as he has or possesses to the aforesaid Henry Doyal his heirs or assigns for ever
against the Claims and demand of the said John B Lawrence his heirs or assigns and against any person
