This Indenture made this the 30th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty one between James Vapor of the first part John Moore trustee of the second part and Thomas Partlow of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witness that whereas the said James Vapor stands justly indebted to Thomas Partlow in the sum of six thousand and forty six dollars due by bond bearing date this 30th September eighteen hundred and forty one and being due & payable the first day of March eighteen hundred and forty two, which debt the said James Vapor is desirous to secure and pay unto the said Thomas Partlow in consideration thereof and in further consideration of one dollar to him the said James Vapor in hand paid by the said John Moore before the signing sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said James Vapor doth hereby acknowledge. In the said James Vapor doo for himself his heirs and assigns give grant bargain sell and deliver by these presents both given granted, sold and delivered to him the said John Moore his heirs and assigns forever for the purpose herein after mentioned one certain tract or parcel of Land with all its appurtenances containing three hundred and twenty one bounded as follows by the lines belonging to the side of Godthorpe Pond Arthur Drury Esq Davis Thurgers Lewis Gyles Crocker and Gilbert Drury's land and also my slave Henry whom I purchased at the sale of Richard Wells. To have and to hold the above tract of Land and Negro boy and every part thereof free and clear from the burden of any incumbrance of any person or persons whatsoever unto him the said John Moore his heirs and assigns forever in trust nevertheless that the said John Moore his executor, administrators or assigns shall and may at any time when required by Thomas Partlow to sell the said tract of Land and slave Henry to the highest bidder for ready money first giving twenty days notice of the time and place of the sale by publicly advertising at the Court house door and the money arising therefrom by the date of the sale used negro boy to apply to the payment of the debt due to the said Thomas Partlow and as much thereof as remaining due or unpaid the interest together with cost accruing by reason of these presents and to make and execute a deed to the purchaser thereof and the balance of the money if any to pay to the said James Vapor his heirs or assigns.
