This Indenture made and entered into this 27th day of October in the year of our Lord 1841
between Catharine Harrison of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
Henry Moore of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Catharine Harrison
doe for and in Consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars and — Cents to her in hand
paid by the said Henry Moore at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted sold conveyed and delivered unto the said
Henry Moore and to his heirs and assigns &c. forever all the right title and interest of her the said
Catharine Harrison in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County
of Southampton on the N. E. of fled Swamp containing three hundred and forty two & one
hd the same more or less and bounded by the lines of the said Henry Moore David Moore
and Mark A. Jones and the flat Swamp together with all houses out houses and improvements
thereunto attached also but the said Catharine Harrison's right to negro man by name Simon
the right ^{heretofore} sold or intended to be sold being the right she derived from her Brother William
Rumney dec'd last will and Testament in which be giving the said Catharine Harrison the said
tract of Land and negro Simon during her natural life unto him the said Henry Moore and
his heirs forever she the said Catharine with by these presents warrant and forever defensed the
life interest of her the said Catharine to said land and negro Simon against the Claim and
demand of her the said Catharine Harrison and against the Claim and demands of all persons
claiming under and against the Claim and demand of all and every other person ^{person or} whatsoever it
being the true intent by this deed to sell and convey the said life Estate of which the said
Catharine Harrison is entitled to in said land and negro Simon by virtue of the last will and
Testament of her brother William Rumney therefore she the said Catharine by these presents
warrant and forever defensed all such title as vested in her unto the said Henry Moore
