Whereas This Indenture made the 28th day of October in the year One thousand eight hundred and fifty One between Jonas Edwards and Martha his wife on the first part and Spikes Beale on the other part. Witnesseth that the said Jonas Edwards and Martha his wife in consideration of the sum of fifty two dollars to them in hand paid by the said Spikes Beale have bargain and sold unto by these presents do and each of them with bargain and sell unto the said Spikes Beale his heirs and assigns forever all the right title and interest which they the said Jonas Edwards and Martha his wife may now have or hereafter acquire into the trust or parcels of land now held by Nancy Edwards widow of Abington Edwards dec^d as her dower in the lands of the said Abington Edwards. Also all right title and interest which he the said Jonas Edwards may have in and to any slaves held by the said Nancy Edwards as her dower in the slaves of the aforesaid Abington Edwards or well as all and every other interest which he the said Jonas Edwards may have in any other estate held by said Nancy Edwards and he the said Jonas Edwards and Martha his wife do hereby will for the aforesaid consideration bargain and sell in like manner unto the said Spikes Beale all right title and interest which they or either of them may have in and to any property real or personal now held by Elizabeth (or as she is more commonly called Betty) Williams by virtue of a life estate which she has in the same also all and every other interest which they may have in any other property held by the said Betty Williams. To have and to hold said land or interest therein together with the slaves or such interest therein as he the said Jonas Edwards may have together with all and every other species of property herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto him the said Spikes Beale his heirs and assigns forever.
