Drury of the same County and State of the second part. and Samuel and J. Drury James Mathews Sampson & Rice John Whitehead M^{rs} A Jones and Nathaniel Francis of the same County and State and William Newthorn of Petersburg of the third part. Witnesseth that whereas the said J. J. Drury the said M^{rs} L Coville is justly indebted to the said Sam^l and J. Drury in the sum of two hundred dollars or thereabouts as will appear by their Claim also to James Mathews in the sum of One hundred and twenty dollars or thereabouts - also that Sampson & Rice is the s^d M^{rs} L Coville Deb^t for hire of negro firm to J^{os} T. Blount guardⁿ of the orphans of Rob^t S. Mungrove dec^d for twenty or twenty five dollars also that the s^d John Whitehead is Deb^t for s^d Coville to J^{os} T. Blount guardⁿ and dec^d of Theophilus Burrow dec^d for the sum of twenty one or two dollars or thereabouts also that the said M^{rs} A Jones being said Coville Deb^t for the hire of negro firm for twenty or twenty five dollars the date and demand of all of which Claims may be ascertained by reference to them also a debt due to Nathaniel Francis for the sum of sixty or seventy dollars reference to the Claim will more fully appear also a debt due to M^{rs} Newthorn of Petersburg for the sum of one hundred dollars or thereabouts and being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the said debts and our bond of the aforesaid Securitizing from suffering or being injured by the same security ships in the said M^{rs} L Coville got and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said J. J. Drury at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have this day given granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain sold and confirm unto him the said J. J. Drury and his representatives forever all the life estate he may be or is entitled to from a certain
