will and truly to be made to the President and members of the Library fund and their
successors in office we bind ourselves his executors and administrators jointly and
severally for my by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the 15th day of November 1821
The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Samuel H. Holmes
was on the 18th day of October 1821 by the school Commissioners in and for the County of
Southampton appointed their treasurer for the year ending on the 31st day of December 1822
Bew of the said Samuel H. Holmes shall faithfully apply and account for all monies which
may come to his bands by virtue of his Office and shall performe and execute every act and
thing appertaining to his Office according to law then the above obligation to be void or else
