Witnesseth that the said Samuel Kelle and Mary his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge they have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto release convey and Confirm unto the said Gilbert Vick his heirs and assigns fifty Acres of Land being the whole or a part of the tract of Land which was made to the said Kelle in right of his marriage and bounded as follows North by the land of the said Vick East by the land of the said Vick and Robert Pritchard and South by the land of James Bell. To have and to hold the said Tract of Land unto and to the heirs of the said Gilbert Vick with the appurtenances and all the said Estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Samuel Kelle and Mary his wife to the said Gilbert Vick his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Samuel Kelle and Mary his wife do hereby promise and agree for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators to and with the said Gilbert Vick his heirs and assigns to warrant secure and forever defend the said Tract of Land or parcel of Land and premises against the lawful claims and demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever, for party of whom of the said Samuel Kelle and Mary A. K. his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year above written.
