Thousand Eight hundred and Thirty two executors to Joseph Pritlow deceased a trust to
secure a debt due James Scott deceased for the sum of One hundred and sixty two dollars and
Thirty eight Cents, and since the execution of the said Dade the said trustee has departed
this life and by a decree of the County Court of Southampton the said John Drury has
been appointed trustee to carry into effect the said deed. This Bondenture therefore witnesseth
the that for and in consideration of the premises and for the sum of Two hundred dollars
in hand paid to the said John Drury trustee as aforesaid by the said Edward Turner
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John Drury trustee as aforesaid
hereby granted absolute and unlimited ~~releasement~~ and power quit claimeth and by these
present do fully and absolutely grant release and forever quit claim unto the
said Edward Turner his heirs and assigns forever all the whole right title interest property
of claim and demands whatsoever in law or equity of them and each of them the
said Joseph Pritlow deceased and John Drury trustee as aforesaid of and
to a certain tract or parcel of Land Conveyed by the said Edward Turner to the said
Joseph Pritlow deceased to secure a debt due James Scott deceased Containing by Estimation
Twenty Acres with the appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and to hold the
said lot of ground with its appurtenances to the said Edward Turner his heirs and
assigns forever so that the said John Drury his heirs or the heirs of the said
Joseph Pritlow deceased or James Scott deceased nor either of them nor either of their
heirs nor any person claiming under them shall by any ways or means hereafter
have claim challenging or demand any whole right title or interest of in and to the
said premises or any part thereof they and every of them shall be utterly exclud-
