John Turner This Indenture made this 25th day of October one thousand eight hundred and forty one between Jesse Drury of the one part and Edward Turner of the other part. Witnesseth that whereas Edward Turner of the County of Southampton said on the 15th day of August one thousand eight hundred and thirty two execute to Joseph Parlow dec^d a deed of trust to secure a debt due James Scott dec^d for the sum of One hundred and sixty two dollars and thirty eight Cents, and since the execution of the said Deed the said trustee has departed this life and by a decree of the County Court of Southampton the said Jesse Drury has been appointed trustee to carry into effect the said deed. This Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the premises and for the sum of two hundred dollars in hand paid to the said Jesse Drury trustee as aforesaid by the said Edward Turner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Jesse Drury trustee as aforesaid have granted released and released release and forever quit claimed and by these presents do fully and absolutely grant remise release and forever quit claim unto the said Edward Turner his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever in Law or equity of them and each of them the said Joseph Parlow dec^d James Scott dec^d and Jesse Drury trustee as aforesaid of in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land conveyed by the said Edward Turner to the said Joseph Parlow dec^d to secure a debt due James Scott dec^d containing by Estimation twenty Acres with the appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and to hold the said Lot of ground with its appurtenances to the said Edward Turner his heirs and assigns to the only use and behoof of the said Edward Turner his heirs and assigns forever so that the said Jesse Drury his heirs or the heirs of the said Joseph Parlow dec^d or James Scott dec^d nor either of them nor either of their heirs nor any person claiming under them shall by any ways or means hereafter have claim challenge or demand any estate right title or interest of in and to the said premises or any part thereof They and every of them shall be utterly excluded and barred forever by these presents.
