Williamson of the third part. Whereas that whereas the said Edwin B. Blane is fully indebted to the said Benjamin Williamson in the sum of two thousand four hundred and twelve dollars and to the said Thomas B. Williamson in the sum of two thousand one hundred and fifty seven dollars due by note bearing date even with these presents and being  
desirous to secure the same held by these presents bargained sold Conveyed and  
Conformed and by these presents with bargain all Convey and Conform unto James  
Burris his heirs of any tract of land on which I now live containing twelve  
hundred acres by the name of top and bounded by the lands of Francis Foyner  
James Drury.  
Thomas U. Turner from Harry Benjamin Williamson and John Boy also the  
following slaves, Mul, Daniel, Tom Anis and Elizabeth with all and singular the  
appurtenances to the said Tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and  
the future increase of the female slaves. To have and to hold the said land  
concerning with its appurtenances together with the aforesaid slaves and their future  
increase to the said James Burris and his heirs forever and the said Edwin Blane  
his heirs of shall will and warrant and defend the title of said property to the  
said James Burris upon trust nevertheless that the said James Burris his heirs of  
shall permit the said Edwin B. Blane to remain in quiet possession of said bargain  
premises until sufficient be made in payment of the before mentioned debt either in the  
whole or in part then upon the further tract the said James Burris his heirs of at the  
request of the said Benjamin and Thomas B. Williamson shall set at public sale formerly
