This indenture made and entered into this 25th day of October in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty one between Edward Turner and Amelia Turner his wife of the
one part and James Holme of the other part, witnesseth that the said Edward Turner and Amelia his wife
for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars Current Money of Virginia
... to them in hand paid or accrued to be paid by them the said James Holme at or before the sealing
and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and
sold and by these presents do hereby bargain and sell unto the said James Holme his heirs
and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land and being in the County of Southampton and
State of Virginia Containing by Estimation seventy acres by the sume more or less and bounded
as follows (viz) Beginning at a Ash standing in the mouth of the deep Branch in Burnell
William's line thence up the run of said Branch to a red-oak standing in John William's
line thence along said line to a red-oak a new made corner tree standing at the head of
a small branch thence down the run of said Branch to a black gum a new made corner
tree standing in the south prong of the Cypress swamp thence down the run of said
swamp to a black gum a new corner tree standing in the fork of said swamp thence up
the north prong of said swamp to the ash a new corner tree standing in the mouth
of said deep branch in Burnell William's line being the first station together with the over-
plus and reversion remainder and remaining yearly and other rents and profits and every
part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the tenements
hereditaments and all and singular the property and appurtenances heretofore mentioned
or intended to be bargained and sold with every part and parcel thereof unto the said
James Holme his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Edward Turner and Amelia his
wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of Land unto the said James Holme his
heirs and assigns against the claim of third the said Edward Turner and Amelia his
wife their heirs and assigns and any person or persons claiming under them shall
will and a freely warrant and forever defend by these presents. And witness wherefore the
said Edward Turner and Amelia his wife have hereunto set their hands and seal the
day and year first above written -

having the deed of marriage fully explained to her she the said Amelia Turner acknowledged the
same to be her act and deed and declared she had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same
and that she wished not to retract it living under our hands and seals this 25th day of October 1841
