This Indenture made this 29th day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty one between Benjamin Edmunds of the County of Halifax in the State of North Carolina of the one part by William H Edmunds of the aforesaid County and State his Attorney in fact. and John Burkhead of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part- Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Edmunds by his said Attorney acting under and by virtue of a power of attorney bearing date the 22nd day of November Eighteen hundred and forty one and admitted to Record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton in the State of Virginia on the 29th day of November 1841 for use in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars of lawful money of the United States to his said Attorney in hand paid for his use were bequeit by the said John Burkhead at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which the said Benjamin Edmunds by his said Attorney does hereby acknowledge hath granted bequeit and sold and by these presents doth grant bequeit sell and convey unto the said John Burkhead his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit.
