Lile of the County of Southampton State of Virginia Common Council of the County of Northampton State of North Carolina John Barrie of the County of Southampton State of Virginia Nicholas Board of the County of Northampton State of North Carolina of the third and last part, Witnesseth that whereas the said James Sherrill stands jointly indebted to the said Lile, Board, Barrie and Board in the sum of One hundred and Eighteen dollars and nineteen Cents by bond bearing date the 15th April 1880 subject to a credit the 29th March 1881 of thirty three dollars and eighty Cents also one other bond bearing date the 15th June 1880 payable one day after date for the sum of thirty six dollars and seventy nine Cents and the said James Sherrill being willing and desirous to secure and save himself the said Lile, Board, Barrie and Board their debt.
