Pinnington became the purchaser for the sum of fifteen hundred and ten dollars and - Cents: Now for the Consideration of the said agreed sum of money of Virginia to him secured to be paid at once before the meeting and selling of these premises the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both as Excuter of said Joseph Blanton dec^d and conveyed and by these presents as bargain sold and conveyed unto the said John & P. Pinnington his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land which the said Joseph Blanton dec^d died seized and possessed lying and being in the County of Southampton containing five hundred and eighty two acres be the same more or less and bounded by the three Creeks the lands of Henry P. Hays and Mary Taylor with all and singular the appurtenances and promising the reversion and issuing monies and revenues yearly and other rents issues and profits and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and the Tenements hereunto and all and singular other the promising herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said John & P.
