One thousand eight hundred and forty One. Between Benjamin J. Griffin and Susan
his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and
James McMurry of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the
said Benjamin J. Griffin and Susan his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
four hundred and forty five dollars current money to them in hand paid by the
said James McMurry at once before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof they do hereby acknowledge they have granted bargained and sold unto by these
presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said James McMurry and his heirs and assigns
all that tenement tract or parcel of land by
and lying in the County aforesaid being the tract which the said Griffin bought of Sir
Edward and George Gardiner Esqrs and bounded as follows. Beginning at a white
Oak in the S.E. corner a corner between said Griffin's other Land and Thomas's place
thence Northward to a old stone Eastward to a old stone Northwardly to a pine
in the mossy branch a new line agreed on ^{between} the parties, thence down said
branch to a pine, the corner between Samuel Denson Arlington Garden and said
Griffin's place along a line of marked trees between said Griffin and Arlington
Gardner to a old stone corner between said Griffin Arlington Gardner and Edward
