This indenture made the 10th day of Decr. 1841 between Mills & Lawrence of the County of Isle of Wight and State of Virginia of the one part. and William Lawrence of the same County of the other part. Witnesseth That the said Mills & Lawrence for use in consideration of the sum of One thousand and fifty dollars and twenty five Cents to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said William Lawrence the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell and Convey to the said William Lawrence his heirs and assigns, a certain Lot piece or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows beginning at a willow oak near meadow swamp on the side of the road then down said Road to the old black water bridge thence down black water River to Gordon Johnsons line thence said Johnsons line of marshes thence to a black gum & Cornus tree of Allen Edwards line to the first Station. Containing One thousand and a half acres by the same more or less together with all the houses and improvements thereon and appurtenances whatsoever. To have and to hold the said Lot piece or parcel of Land with all the improvements thereon to the only proper use and behoof of the said William Lawrence his heirs and assigns forever.
