 to the said Milton S. Beaumont in the sum of two hundred dollars Current Money of Va
 with growing interest - Now therefore to secure the said sum of two hundred dollars
 and for the further sum of One dollar to him the said Thomas Beaumont sent in hand
 paid by the said Thomas D. Beaumont at and before the making and delivery of this
 Indenture the receipt is hereby acknowledged. with grant bargain and sell and by their
 parents hath granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed and confirmed the
 following property and all it may have (Bdy) Two Horses one single gig and harness
 One bridle and saddle One Cart and wheels One curtain bedstead One feather bed and
 furniture four head of Cattle and their increase One yoke of Oxen two head of sheep and
 their increase One Chest three County box of old Tools two plows three axes two gutting
 hoes One pair Iron wings One Canoe One apple mill and wheel one gristmill two
 tubs five window chairs &c to the said Thomas D. Beaumont upon trust nevertheless
 the said Thomas D. Beaumont may and shall at any time at the request of the said
 Milton S. Beaumont advertise and sell the said property before mentioned for ready
 Money after giving ten days public notice thereof and of the Money arising therefrom
 pay and discharge all reasonable expenses attending the premises Then the net amount
 and the surplus if any pay and return to the said Thomas Beaumont sent or his legal
