 said Joseph T. Blane at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have this very grantee hereunder sealed and delivered and by
 these presents do grant bargain sell enfeoff confound and deliver unto the said Joseph T. Blane unto
 him his heirs and assigns forever. One certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the
 County of Southampton and in the upper district of St. Luke parish and containing by recent survey
 two hundred and Eighty eight and a half acres by the sum more or less as being a tract of Land left
 by the wife of Bowell Garbrough and to his wife Margaret during her life and at her death to his
 son Howell Garbrough aforesaid in fee together with all the improvements thereunto attached the
 said tract of Land being bounded as follows to wit - Beginning at a red oak on the side of the road
 leading from Fairland to Hiley's Bridge a lone tree between the parties and Benjamin Ellis
 thene downe the various course of said tract to a pine corner for said David Drew thence to a
 Maple standing in branch thence downe the various course of said branch a line between
 the parties and said David Drew to a pine tree corner for said Drew James Garbrough first
 and the parties thence a line to a pine a corner or allow tree for a? Drift of Garbrough
 and the parties thence a line between the parties and for Garbrough to the road before named
 thence up said road to a line tree on side of the road it being a line tree for James Person first
 and the parties aforesaid thence a line between them wch the aforesaid to a post oak a
 corner for Henry Moore and others thence a dividing line between them and said Moore the
 various course designated by line tree to Samuel B. Mowders line thence up his line to a gum
 in the pole branch thence up the various course of said branch to a Beech wch line
 for Benjamin Ellis thence along a? Ellis line to the red oak on side of the road etc
 beginning. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and growing 25
 improvements for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph T. Blane and his
 heirs forever and the said Margaret G. Nicholson and Howell Garbrough as at her last
 covenant and agree to and with the said Joseph T. Blane that they will by these presents
 for themselves their and each of their heirs and theirs executors &c. warrant and for ever convey
 the right and title in and to the land and premises and improvements hereby above mentioned
 to be sold and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said Joseph T. Blane his heirs
 and assigns forever. Against the claim and demands of themselves and against the claim and
 demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. On Testimony whereof the said
