This indenture made this 27th day of Nov. one thousand eight hundred and forty one between Richard Harris and wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Brown a man of colour of the said County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Richard Harris and being his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Eight dollars lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said William Brown at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them bargain and sell unto the said William Brown his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and State of the South side of flat swamp adjoining the lands of Richard Harris which formerly belonged to Curruand Dwyer and adjoining the lands of Aaron Strophel both containing by survey twenty two acres be the same more or less with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Land. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the aforesaid premises unto the said William Brown his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Richard Harris and being his wife doth for themselves their heirs and assigns forever defend the right and title of the said tract of Land unto the said William Brown his heirs and assigns forever.
