This Oath deponent makes this 2^d day of December in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred
 and forty One before Joshua Blunt of the County of Lucy of the one part and Benjamin G. Drew
 of the County of Southampton of the other part all of the state of Virginia. Witnesseth that for and
 in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Joshua Blunt these grants
 bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell enfeoff and confide unto the said
 Benjamin G. Drew and to his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land
 lying and situated in the County of Southampton and bounded in the following manner
 by Gregories Branch on the East by the Land belonging to the heirs of Harry Bellwood in
 the North and by the lands belonging to the said Benjamin G. Drew on the West and South
 it being the same Land the said Joshua Blunt purchased at the rate of One hundred Dollars
 and the same which Blunt had resided on at the time of his death supposed to contain
 One hundred and thirty acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the
 appurtenances thereto belonging and the revision and reversing remainder and yearly
 yearly and other rents ipsius and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have
