This Indenture made and entered into this 3rd day of January in the year 1802 between Benj^d Miller and Temperance Miller formerly Temperance Blair his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph T. Blair of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benj^d Miller and his wife Temperance for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Jos^t Blair at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted granted sold conveyed confirmed and delivered unto the said Jos^t Blair his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises together with all improvement thereunto attached lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by former survey one hundred and two or three more or less bounded by the lands of the said Jos^t Blair and Jacob Runney they the s^d Benj^d Miller and Temperance Miller his wife hereby conveying to themselves the full privilege and right of having access to and the free liberty of entering any of their family and of being interred themselves in the grave place and the aforesaid Land and that the said Jos^t Blair doth by these presents guarantee well warrant the said privilege unto them and the said Benj^d Miller and Temperance formerly Temperance Blair doth by these presents convey unto the said Jos^t Blair his heirs and assigns forever all their right title and interest in and to the aforesaid tract of Land and premises together with the improvements thereto abovesaid it being the land the said Temperance hired from her father Jos^t Blair's est. and they the said Benj^d Miller and Temperance Miller his wife doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Jos^t Blair his heirs &c to admit and signify that they will for themselves their and each of their heirs warrant and forever defend all the right title and interest in and to said Land and premises hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed and every part and parcel thereof against the claim and demand of every other person or persons whatsoever with the privilege of the grave place before named guaranteed to them exceptive unto him the said Jos^t Blair and his heirs and assigns forever.
