This Indenture made this 21st day of January one thousand eight hundred and
 forty two by and between John Foyner of the first part James J. Williams of the second part
 and Jesse Drury of the third part Witnesseth that the said John Foyner in order to secure
 a debt due from him to the said James J. Williams on three notes one Executed on the 1st
 day of November in the year 1841 for seven dollars and twenty five Cents one Executed
 on the 15th day of December for forty two dollars and twenty four Cents one Executed
 on the 23^d day of January in the year 1842 for seventeen dollars and twenty nine
 Cents payable with Interest from the date of the said notes but more especially for
 and in consideration of one dollar to have the said John Foyner in hand paid by the
 said Jesse Drury at and before the issuing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Foyner for himself his heirs Executors
 and administrators both grantors bargainors and sole vend by their persons and legal
 bargain and sell unto the said Jesse Drury the following property to wit One bay
 Horse one sorrel Horse one tuble one pair flat Iron one pair loose chains
 Do have and to hold the said property as above mentioned to him the said Jesse
 Drury his heirs and assigns forever upon the following trust (viz) that if the said
 John Foyner his heirs Executors and administrators or either of them shall die or before
