6 Branch of the County of Southampton of the first part and Thomas Postle Sheriff of the said
Postle of the County of the second part witness that whereas the said Benjamin Branch is now confined in the
jail of Southampton County by virtue of two executions one in favour of E& Briggs and
J Drury late Merchants of and one in favour of John Vick and the said Benjamin Branch
being desirous of availing himself of the benefit of the insolvent debt. Now therefore for and
in Consideration of the promising the said Benjamin Branch has granted bargained and
sold and by these presents does grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Postle Sheriff
of Southampton County apnounced all that tract of Land in the County of Bradwell and
State of Kentucky containing One hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less
which was devised by the last will and Testament of Drury Colton to the said
Benjamin Branch adjoining the land of Giltberg Colton and others. To have and
to hold the said tract of Land to him the said Thomas Postle Sheriff ^{of the said} aforementioned
for the purpose of paying and satisfying the executions in favour of E& Briggs and
A. J. Drury late partners of and John Vick as aforesaid. In Testimony whereof the
