This Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of December in the year 1831
 between Joseph T. Claus and Elizabeth Claus his wife of the one part and John A. Parnold and
 Benjamin Williamson of the other part. All of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
 Witnesseth that the said Joseph T. Claus and wife Elizabeth for and in consideration of the sum
 of two hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Williamson
 Sch^r. A Parnold the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have this day granted bargain
 sold and confirmed unto by these presents do give grant bargain sell and confirm unto
 the said John A. Parnold and Benjamin Williamson One half of the interest and title former
 owned by Allen Jones dec^d to a mill and mill seat called Blunts old mill, which one
 half being the two shares held by Elizabeth Claus formerly Elizabeth Jones and Rebecca
 T. Coville dec^d formerly Rebecca T. Jones by their father Allen Jones wife and the share
 which Rebecca T. Coville was entitled being purchased by the said Jos^t T. Claus and a deed
 made to him by Cassius Butler trustee for the said Rebecca T. Coville and attested by writing
 of a written request from d^d Rebecca T. Coville to said C. Butler trustee as well more fully appear
 by reference to said deed which is duly recorded in Southampton. Now this Indenture Witnesseth
 that the said Joseph T. Claus and wife Elizabeth do hereby for and in consideration as aforesaid give
 grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said John A. Parnold and Benjamin Williamson and to
 their heirs forever the one share of the mill and mill seat aforesaid together with the said
 share of all land improvements well all and every advantage attached to said mill and
 the one share being one eighth part of the whole mill and mill seat it being the share
 held by the said Joseph T. Claus in right of his wife Elizabeth also the one share which
 the said Joseph Claus purchased of C. Butler trustee for Rebecca T. Coville it being also one
 eighth of the whole mill - mill seat improvements &c. thereto attached; And the said
 Joseph T. Claus and Elizabeth his wife doth by these presents, warrant and forever give
 the title of the one share of the said mill - mill seat to which the said Jos^t T. Claus
 is entitled in right of his wife unto the said Benjamin Williamson and John A. Parnold
 to them and their heirs forever. Also doth by these presents warrant and forever give
 the title of the one share which is due to the said Joseph T. Claus by the d^d Benjamin
 trustee as aforesaid which title is vested in him the said Joseph T. Claus by d^d deed to
 the said J. T. Claus doth hereby warrant and no other title unto them the said Benj^a
 Williamson and John A. Parnold to them and their heirs forever. For Testimony whereof
