This Indenture made this 2nd day of October in the year of our Lord 1821 between William
 A Jones trustee to a deed of trust of the first part James Jones of the second part and Edward
 P Turner of the third part whereas the said James Jones on the 22nd day of June in the
 year of our Lord 1821 in order to secure the payment of the sum of One hundred and fifty
 dollars and fifteen cents to the said Edward P Turner did by Indenture of trust of that date
 convey to the said Mr A Jones his heirs &c the following property to wit One negro woman
 named Jenny upon trust for the use and purposes in said Indenture mentioned and
 whereas since the executing of the said deed of trust the said James Jones hath fully
 satisfied and paid the said Edward P Turner the sum or sums of money there
 secured which the said Edward P Turner doth hereby acknowledge. Now this Indenture
 witnesseth that for the consideration aforesaid as well as for the further consideration of ten
 dollars in hand paid by the said James Jones to the said Mr A Jones at and before the
 executing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and
 the said Mr A Jones with the assent and approbation of the said Edward P Turner signed
 by his being a party to these presents, and the said Edward P Turner have granted
 bargained and sold remised released and confirmed and by these presents do grant
 bargain and sell remise release and confirm unto the said James Jones all the right
 full interest claim and demand both at Law and in equity, which the said Mr A
 Jones have or hold in the above slave named Jenny. To have and to hold the said
 slave Jenny to the said James Jones his heirs and assigns forever to the use and
 behoof of him the said James Jones his heirs Executors administrators
 and assigns forever and the said Mr A Jones for himself his heirs &c the above
 mentioned slave unto the said James Jones his heirs &c in as full and ample
 manner as the same was warranted by the said James Jones by the ... and of
 Trust before recited do warrant the same to the said James Jones against the
 Claim or Claims of him the said Mr A Jones, and all persons claiming under the said William A Jones
