in the sum of one hundred and sixteen pence 29th 1842 for such nine dollars and sixteen cents one other
due 25th December 1832 value pence 29th 1842 for thirty five dollars the said Nat Day is willing and
desirous to secure the said Miley Cook therefore, this Indenture witnesseth that the said Nat Day as
in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said John R. Boryant at or
before the executing and delivery of these presents the full receipt is hereby acknowledged he the said
Nat Day has granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain and sell unto
the said John R. Boryant the following property to wit: 4 cows and 7 shoats 15 lbs, cord 600th value
fork 3 sticks blue powder cut and whole 2 pots one spade one flint one bed and furniture one
bed room and increase 1 spinning wheel 1 board 2 chests 2 chairs 1 cupboard plate 2 dishes
2 traps 1 cast plough 3 plough hays 2 counter 2 grub hays and 1 cow, crop of corn 1000th value
of. made and the premises this the present year whereon the said Nat Day now lives. To have
and to hold the said premises before mentioned unto the said John R. Boryant his heirs Executors
administrators or assigns forever. Upon trust nevertheless that the said John R. Boryant
immediately upon the request of the said Miley Cook his Executors administrators or assigns
having ascertained the time and place of the sale of the said property at least fifteen days prior to the
day of sale at three public places in said County proceed to sell the same to the highest bidder
for cash and out of the money arising from the sale of the said property in the first place pay
and satisfy all reasonable charges attending the sale and carrying into effect the execution then the
debt above mentioned and the residue of money if any arising from said sale aforesaid to the
use of said Nat Day his Executors administrators or assigns. And Menif whereof the parties
