KNOW all men by these presents that we Thomas Atkinson and Sarah Atkinson of the
State of Virginia and County of Southampton for and in consideration of the sum of two
hundred dollars paid us by Henry D Bailey of the State and County aforesaid the receipt
whereof we hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey to the said Henry D
Bailey his heirs and assigns a Certain tract or parcel of land in the aforesaid State and
County lying on Pottery Road and bounded as follows (Viz) Commencing at the Road
at a branch called ready Neck and from thence down the run of said Branch to a large
Branch proper from thence it takes a northerly direction to post Oaks and the west side
of Benjamin B Washington's land from thence to a small pond and through the center of
the pond and immediately down the run of the branch leading out of the pond
still running in northerly direction until it strikes the main run of a creek swamp
from thence up the run of the swamp in a meandering Northerly direction until
it comes in the main run of the aforesaid swamp with the land of Jesse Hunt
and from thence it takes a west direction up to the mouth of a branch called the
Baileys branch then making a little curve to a Maple tree it then resumes its westerly
course keeping the lands of Jesse Hunt etc. on the north until it reaches a large
cypress line at an old dogwood which is now dead it then takes a South
direction keeping George Baileys land on the west down the road at the branch
first named to have and to hold the same unto Henry D Bailey his heirs
and assigns to his use their use and behoof forever. And we Covenant with the
said Henry D Bailey his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully ^{seized in} ~~the~~ of the
premises that they are free of all incumbrances and that we will warrant
and defend the same to the said Henry D Bailey his heirs and assigns forever
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. In witness whereof
we hereunto set our hands and affix our seals the 2nd day of February
in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty two
