French and a tract of land containing One hundred and five acres more or less - which deed has been submitted to Record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County on the 23rd day of December 1840 and the said Samuel Wallace having fully paid off and discharged the debt since the execution of the said deed of Trust Now Therefore the said L. R. Edwards and James F. French for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid have revised released and confirmed and do further release and confirm unto the said Samuel Wallace his heirs and assigns the aforesaid tract or parcel of land. To have and to hold the same unto him the said Samuel Wallace his heirs and assigns forever against the claim or demand of the said Edwards and French and those claiming under them - And Testimony whereof the said Edwards and French have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this 22nd day of February 1842 -
