This Indenture made this 28th day of February in the year One thousand Eight hundred and
forty two between Jesse Drury of the first part Arthur A. Drury of the second part and William
D. Hood of the third part and all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth
That whereas William D. Hood stands security to the said Jesse Drury for the sum of two hundred
and sixteen dollars and fifty eight Cents by bond bearing date and in demand the second day
of April 1841 which said sum is made payable to Alfred P. Bailey the administrator of
James Holt's a.d. to whom when the said sum of money is due, and whereas the said
Jesse Drury is willing and desirous to secure the said William D. Hood in case of any
default of payment of the said bond on his part by the said Jesse Drury for and in
consideration of the same and for the further consideration of One dollar Virginia
Currency to him in hand paid or secured to be paid at or before the making and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold aliened conveyed
released and confirmed and by these presents does bargain and sell alien convey release and
confirm unto Arthur A. Drury of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the
