This Indenture made and entered into this 16th day of March in the year 1822 between Edwin D Nash and James M Doyle of the County of Southampton of the first part Leticia R Edwards of the same County of the second part and Firling Bellahone of the County of Southampton and James B Bloodgood Esq^r of the Borough of Norfolk of the third part. Whereas the said Edwin D Nash and James M Doyle Merchants and partners trading under the firm and style of Nash and Doyle in formered in the County aforesaid are justly indebted unto the said Firling Bellahone in the sum of four hundred and sixty three dollars eighteen cents by note bearing date the 16th day of March 1822 and to the said Jas B Bloodgood Esq^r in the sum of four hundred and sixty two dollars by note dated the 23rd of September 1821, in the further sum of One hundred and eighty three 1/100 dollars by note bearing date 25th November 1821 and the further sum of 33 1/100 dollars by note bearing date 16th March 1822 and being willing to secure and provide for the payment of the said sums of money with the interest which may accrue thereon have agreed to the property herein after mentioned unto the said Leticia R Edwards in trust for that purpose. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said Edwin D Nash and James M Doyle for and in consideration of the promises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to them by the said Leticia R Edwards in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold assigned transferred and made over unto by these presents do grant bargain sell assign transfer and make over unto the said Leticia R Edwards his Executors ^{or} assigns and assigns all their stock of goods wares and Merchandise now in hand - To have and to hold the said goods wares and Merchandise unto him the said Leticia R Edwards his Executors ^{or} assigns forever. Upon the following trust that the said Edwards by himself or his agent which he is hereby authorized to employ shall proceed to make sale of the said goods wares and merchandise by retail either privately or publicly and upon such terms as to him shall seem best for the parties concerned and apply the proceeds of the sale as follows that is to say first to ^{defray} the costs and expenses attending this trust secondly pay & satisfy the debt informis due to Bellahone with the interest which may thereon have accrued and the balance or so much thereof as may be necessary apply to the payment of the debts aforesaid due James B Bloodgood Esq^r and interest thereon. And if any surplus should then remain pay it over to the said Nash and Doyle.
