The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound William B. Stephenson has been appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as Constable within the said County to supply the vacancy created by the resignation of William A. Bell. Now if the said William B. Stephenson shall and truly discharge the duties of the Office of Constable in the said County during his Continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and Virtue.
