This Indenture made and entered into on this 19th day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred forty two between Benjamin Lamb and Susan his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Thomas Ridley of the same County and State of the other part. Witness that the said Benjamin Lamb and Susan his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and Eighty Eight dollars Current Money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Ridley at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do now such of them doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto him the said Thomas Ridley his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's containing by a late Survey being four Acre by the same more or less, it being a part of the tract of Land whereon said Benjamin Lamb now resides, and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a pine a corner for Charles Bryant also a new corner for said Benjamin Lamb in said Thomas Ridley's line thence along said Thomas Ridley, line 127° N 72° E to a red oak thence 131° N 14° E to a pine thence 116° N 14° E to a great oak thence 92 1/2° N 55° E to a post a corner thence 98 1/2° E 142° E to a small red oak standing near the corner of said Benjamin Lamb's field as near corner for said Benjamin Lamb in said Thomas Ridley's line thence along a new line of marked trees N 26 3/4° W 58 1/4° E to the beginning. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of Land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances therto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Thomas Ridley his heirs and assigns forever and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Ridley his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Lamb and Susan his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators as and each of them doth hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said Thomas Ridley his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
